Mossley Walks 2

Throughout the week there will be the chance to pick self guided walking opportunities from a number of the Mossley Town Team developed Inspector Gawper mystery walks around Mossley.

Sat 4th May 10.00am

Litterbugs. Join Sally Hamer & Mossley LitterBugs at Woodend Mill for a social walk and litter pick around the Mill trails and towpaths. (1-2 miles)

Sat 4th May 12.00 noon

Mossley Men's Mooch. A gentle walk and chat to enjoy open air and good conversation starting from Mossley Station, then exploring the streets and trails in the area (c.3 miles) Walks specifically designed for men's exercise and chat.

Sun 5th May

Town Team Mystery Trail. Family friendly. Help Inspector Gawper trail solve his dilemma whilst discovering stories about Mossley places. New QR coded route information with a quiz questions as a self-guided walk. Downloadable from the Town Council website.

Mon 6th May 12.00 noon

Signs of Spring Walk. Join Jayne to walk whilst taking in our natural surroundings, observing the signs of spring. Create a natural artwork with found materials along the way and enjoy a brew back at The Vale. Castle Hill over Moor Edge road, to Huddersfield road, then to the Vale. (Approx. 1.7mi / 2.8KM long. Up to 2 hrs.)

Tues 7th May 12.00 noon

Mossley 3 Counties Walk. An opportunity to walk and explore the 3 historic counties of Mossley without ever leaving the the town. Meet at Mossley Market Ground Stamford Street. See the views of Mossley, discuss some of the exciting history of the area. (c4-5Miles)

Wed 8th May 2.00pm

Mossley Art Trail Walk. Join Chris Cyprus, Paul Dowthwaite and members of the Town Team to discover the stories behind the art works around Mossley. Meet at the Station. A fun and informative walk. (c1-2miles)

Thurs 9th May 12.00 noon

Micklehurst Trail Walk. Meet at Mossley Station to walk along the Micklehurst Trail to Well-i 'hole returning along the Huddersfield narrow canal. (3-4 miles)

Thurs 9th May 6.30pm

Wander Inn Top Mossley. A leisurely social walk exploring the current and former inns, beer houses, licensed premises, legends and characters of Top Mossley. Using as reference Rob Magee's : Mossley Pubs & their licensees. Starting at The Fleece Inn Stamford Street an opportunity to discover new stories and enjoy the convivial atmosphere. (1-2miles)

Fri 10th May 2.00pm

A photo walk featuring Micklehurst & Midge Hill. Meeting at Mossley Station. A walk and talk with photo opportunities led by Alan Bishop the discussing the nature and history of Mossley with an opportunity for a pizza before returning to the station. (4-5 miles)

Sat 11th May 10.00am

Mossley Round. Meet at Mossley Market Ground for a circumnavigation (a walk around) of Mossley the highs and lows with plenty of opportunities to enjoy views of the town and countryside. Although the walk has plenty of ascents & descents the walk is at a relaxed pace. (c 8-9 miles)
